**COMMUNITY EVENT.** Last year the school received a \$2,000 grant via the Surf Coast Shire's Climate Emergency Community Initiative. Most of these funds were used to allow parents/carers use eBikes free of charge for a two-week period to shift travel behaviours as well as attitudes, habits and social norms around how students, parents and carers view active travel to kinder, school and work and get around Anglesea. Some of the funding was earmarked to hold an inclusive community event to raise awareness around how the community can get involved in local action on climate change. This will be held on Monday 30th October from 1:30-2:30pm – more details to come.

**PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT.** Last night staff reviewed our procedures in which we are to close in the event of any Extreme weather. #### Who is eligible?

State Schools' Relief provides support to any Victorian student attending a government school (primary, secondary or specialist), on the advice of the school. Schools are able to submit an application directly, via our online portal, whenever they believe there is a need to support a student whose family/carers are facing difficulty in providing the appropriate uniform, footwear or educational items for attending school.

- · Situations include, but are not limited to:
- Unemployment
- Health issues/illness
- Financial difficulties
- · Independent living and/or homelessness
- · Natural disasters, house fires
- Bereavement
- Domestic violence

All applications are processed within 24 - 48 hours and you will receive confirmation of application/s by email. Orders will then be delivered within 4 working days.
