Contact your child's homegroup teacher to make a time to discuss your concerns.

A follow up meeting will be held to share feedback, successes & challenges. If additional support is required the homegroup teacher will begin a Care Pathway referral for additional support and advice. The Mental Health, Wellbeing and Inclusion Leader may attend the meeting if required.

**Making a Referral** 

During the meeting, the teacher will take notes, listen to your concerns. The Mental Health, Wellbeing and Inclusion Leader may attend the meeting if required.



The agreed strategies & adjustments will be implemented at home and school.

Teachers,
Parents/Carers will make note of observations and document.



During the meeting some strategies and adjustments that could be implemented both at school and at home will be discussed. Together Parents/Carers & Teachers will choose a course of action.
